

Updated COVID-19 Policies

To keep our concerts as safe and comfortable as possible for our guests, artists, and staff, the requirements for entering the hall have recently changed:

- **Audience members will be required to show proof of Covid-19 vaccination and booster shot**, with the most recent dose completed at least two weeks prior to the performance date. *Vaccination cards, digital vaccination proof, or a photo of the vaccination card saved to a phone will all be accepted.*
- **Audience members who are unable to be vaccinated, or whose most recent vaccination is less than 14 days (7 days for booster)**, may provide proof of a negative test result received from a completed lab-certified antigen COVID-19 test within 24 hours prior to entering the concert, or a negative test result received from a completed PCR COVID-19 test within 72 hours prior to entering the concert. *Please have your lab result available for inspection (with the date and time stamp highlighted for quicker processing, if possible).*

If this policy impacts your ability to attend a concert, please get in touch and we will refund or exchange your ticket(s).

In addition, the following guidelines remain in place:

- **Face Coverings:** At this time all venues are requiring guests, staff, and volunteers to wear masks that cover both their nose and mouth while in the building. Masks will be provided if needed.
- **Social Distancing:** Venues are encouraging social distancing by limiting capacity and marking designated seating areas.
- **Advance Ticket Purchases:** To limit box office contact, when possible, please purchase tickets in advance online, by mail, or by phone.
